Maldives uses power outlets and plugs of types C,D,G,J,K &L. Take a look at the pictures below to see what these plugs and power sockets look like: Doesn't look familiar? Do the outlets look different in your country? You'll need a power plug adapter. Be careful!

Does the Maldives use the same plug type as the UK?

Yes, the Maldives uses Type G plugs, which are the same as those used in the UK. Does the Maldives use the same electrical plug type as the US? No, the Maldives does not use the same plug types as the US. You will need an adapter for Type A or B American plugs to fit Type D,G,J,K,or L sockets used in the Maldives.

What types of electrical outlets are used in the Maldives?

When you're planning to visit the Maldives, it's essential to know that the electrical outlets may be different from those you're accustomed to. The Maldives generally uses five types of plug outlet standards: Type D: This plug has three large round pins in a triangular pattern.

Do I need a voltage converter in Maldives?

If your device or power adapter is not dual voltage or you are unsure, and the voltage and/or frequency in Maldives differs from your own country, you should use a voltage converter when plugging in your devices and power adapters in Maldives.
